

Kovalevskaya Grants

Call for applications from mathematicians from Denmark

Overview

The [Kovalevskaya grants](#) support the participation of early career mathematicians at the [International Congress of Mathematicians 2022](#) (July 6–14, 2022, Saint Petersburg).

They cover the local expenses at the congress (including accommodation and meals). Registration fee for the ICM 2022 for the grant recipients will be waived and visa-free entry to the Russian Federation will be arranged.

The Danish [National Committee for Mathematics](#) is responsible for the selection of recipients of the Kovalevskaya Grants from Denmark as the local partner of the organizers of ICM 2022.

The grant does not cover travel costs. For the participants from Denmark, it is expected that these will be covered by the home institution of the recipient. The applicant should arrange this with his/her institution before applying.

Eligibility criteria

The following candidates are invited to apply

- **doctoral students** in mathematics or a related field at universities in Denmark
- mathematicians who obtained their PhD. degree **not earlier than 6 years before the start of ICM 2022** (with possible extensions in case of long-term illness or parental leave), working at an institution in Denmark

2. Send the application and the requested documents (see below) as one pdf-file to Lene Bongaarts via ICM@math.au.dk.

The application deadline is **October 14, 2021**.

Requested documents

- signed application on the standard application form
- CV
- list of publications
- letter of recommendation (signed, on letterhead). The letter of recommendation can also be sent separately if preferred.
