

POPULARIZATION OF MATHEMATICS


"Martin Gardner brought more math to more millions than anyone else." - Richard Guy.

With clarity and enthusiasm, Gardner brought complex theorems and mathematical constructions to a wide audience.



Through Gardner's publications, readers learned about the works of such important thinkers as John H. Conway (*The Game of Life*), Raymond Smullyan (*logic*), Roger Penrose (*tilings*), M.C. Escher (*visual art*) and Benoit Mandelbrot (*fractals*). Gardner's monthly column in *Scientific American* (1956-1981) inspired several cover designs. He published over 100 books on subjects from recreational mathematics, philosophy, and magic to novels and the classic annotated edition of *Alice in Wonderland*.
